<b>Right to Cancel/Rescind</b>	You will receive written notice from your EDC confirming your selection of Frontier as your electric supplier. You have the right to cancel this Agreement without penalty within 7 calendar days following the postmark date on the EDC's confirmation letter.
<b>Renewal Terms</b>	A renewal notice will be sent to you between 45 and 90 days prior to the end of the initial term. After the initial term, your Agreement will automatically continue on a month-to-month basis, and you will pay a variable price per kWh. <b>The renewal is automatic and does not require your affirmative consent, although there may be a change to the price or the terms and conditions of the Agreement.</b>
<b>Independent Seller</b>	Frontier is an independent seller of electric power and energy service, certified by the Public Utility Commission of Ohio (“PUCO”) to act as a certified electric service company. Frontier is not representing, endorsed by, or acting on behalf of, a utility or a utility program, a consumer group or consumer group program, or a governmental body or program of a governmental body.
